2. The "*Fuel Consumption Guide*" is published annually by the Federal Government. The guide can be downloaded from the internet at www.greenhouse.gov.au/fuelguide/index.html. There are different fuel consumption rates for city driving and country driving.
3. Average fuel costs can generally be determined by reference to Australian Bureau of Statistics figures on average retail price of petrol in Australian capital cities, which are released quarterly. Details of the average petrol prices in capital cities, for both leaded and unleaded petrol, can be obtained from the National Information and Referral Service on 1300 135 070.
